RISK ASSESSMENT

HAZARD	RISK	ACTION
Performance Stage Curtain	Curtain could fall over if pulled and hit a member of the audience or small child.	Performer will be aware of position of spectators. Performer will ensure audience members remain on the floor and don't approach or pull the curtain.
Balloons may choke a small child	Small children may put uninflated or burst balloons in their mouths and swallow them and choke	Performer will ensure uninflated balloons are kept away from small children, burst balloon pieces are removed, and balloons are not given directly to very small children (approximately under 3 years)
Electrical Equipment/speakers.	Electricity	Performer will not allow children near the electrical equipment
Roll on box	Roll on Box may cause injury to children if pulled or pushed.	Performer will be aware that Roll on performing box may cause injury and will not allow spectators or volunteers to pull or push.
Sweets/latex balloons	Allergies	It is requested that the booker informs the performer if this may be a problem before the party so the items can either not be used or kept away from the allergic children (depending on their parent's wishes).
Rabbit/live animals	Bite spectator	The magician will be in full control of all animals and only allow children and spectators to touch or stroke animals in his supervision and under his control.
